Background

GCM owns and manages a portfolio of rural properties in Fernbank/Walpa and surrounding areas as part of the Fingerboards Critical Minerals Project. As part of its commitment to responsible land stewardship, GCM is seeking to engage suitably qualified contractors to deliver a range of services on an ongoing basis.

Scope of Work

01. Fencing

Works may include the installation, repair, and maintenance of rural boundary and internal fencing across GCM properties.

- Supply and installation of new rural fencing (plain wire, barbed wire, and post and rail)
- Electrified fencing installation and maintenance
- Inspection and repair of existing boundary and internal fencing
- Replacement of damaged or deteriorated posts, wires, and hardware
- Consultation with GCM team and neighbouring landholders on fencing standards and requirements

02. Mechanical Weed Management

Works may include the control and management of invasive and noxious weed species through mechanical methods.

- Slashing and mowing of weed-affected areas
- Cultivation and soil disturbance to disrupt weed establishment
- Removal and disposal of weed material in accordance with biosecurity requirements
- Mapping and recording of treated areas to support ongoing weed management programs
- Management of priority species including African Love Grass, Apple of Sodom, and Blackberries

03. Chemical Weed Management

Works may include the control and management of invasive and noxious weed species through chemical application.

- Herbicide application (boom spray, spot spray, and targeted application methods)
- Preparation and implementation of chemical treatment programs in line with relevant legislative requirements
- Maintenance of accurate chemical use records and treatment maps
- Management of priority species including African Love Grass, Apple of Sodom, and Blackberries
- Compliance with all relevant EPA, WorkSafe, and agricultural chemical regulations

Contractor Requirements

Contractors responding to this EOI should be able to demonstrate the following:

#	Requirement
1	Relevant experience delivering similar services on rural and agricultural properties
2	Appropriate licences, certifications, and insurance (including public liability)
3	ACUP or equivalent accreditation for chemical weed management applicants
4	Availability to operate across multiple properties in the East Gippsland region
5	Commitment to biosecurity protocols and safe work practices
